



Due to an incredibly high demand on our food and drink vendors we are expanding our food vendor offerings again this year with “A Taste of the Festival” area that is separate from our arts and crafts area. There is no room for additional food/drink vendors there, but a select few more are needed to feed the masses.

The location is a large asphalt lot in the 1000 block of East Marshall, just 2 blocks from the carnival and the same distance from the arts and crafts bazaar. It is on the 4 lane main route, but has no electricity nor water service available – so it comes with a cheaper price than our traditional food vendors located with the arts and crafts. We will provide a dumpster for refuse. This new addition will be well advertised. The price for food vendors in this area is just \$175 for Thursday thru Sunday, April 16-19, 2020. This is a substantial savings over our other rates.

Below you will find an application to be returned no later than February 13, 2020 along with your payment to request your space for our 52nd Annual Dogwood-Azalea Festival. Please keep in mind we will select just 4 to 6 vendors for this area so we will not be accepting all who apply, but rather those with unique offerings. If you are not selected your check will be destroyed or returned to you. PLEASE include an SASE with your application.
