



Due to an incredibly high demand on our food and drink vendors (with an even bigger demand expected in 2018 since it will be our 50th Annual Festival) we are expanding our food vendor offerings this year with an "A Taste of the Festival" area that is separate from our arts and crafts area. There is no room for additional food/drink vendors there, but a select few more are needed to feed the masses.

The location is a large asphalt lot in the 1000 Block of East Marshall, just 2 blocks from from our carnival & the same distance from the arts and crafts show. It is on the 4 lane main route, but has no electricity nor water available -- so it comes at a cheaper price than our traditional food vendors located with the arts and crafts show pay. We will provide a dumpster for refuse. This new addition to the festival will be very well advertised. The price for food vendors at the "Taste of the Festival" area is just \$175 for Friday, Saturday and Sunday. This is a substantial savings over other rates. The dates are April 20, 21, and 22, 2018.

Please keep in mind we will select just four to six vendors for this area so we will not be taking all who apply, but rather selecting vendors based on what we feel will be the best and most unique offerings.
