

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. CROWNING: Contestants will run back-to-back. There will be two crowning ceremonies; at completion of all Princess Divisions and at completion of all Queen Divisions.

2. SCORE CARDS: Sorry, but score cards will not be available.

3. PHOTOS FOR PAPER: Headshots are required for Jr. Miss & Miss contestants ONLY. They will run in the local papers the week of the pageant. Contestants ages 13-18 should e-mail (2) JPEG photos to the pageant coordinator at mdapageant@gmail.com or UPLOAD them in Section 5 of the Registration.

NOTE: If photos are not received by April 7th they will not run in the paper.

4. CHECK-IN: All contestants must be checked-in by 6:15PM and in the back hallway when the pageant starts. Refunds will NOT be given for contestants who miss their division. Only ONE adult (female) will be allowed in the back hallway with each contestant.

5. AMBASSADOR OBLIGATIONS: The Winner of the Jr. Miss & Miss Dogwood Azalea titles MUST be able to fulfill ambassador obligations during the festival (April 21 - 24).

Saturday, April 23 - Ride in the annual parade /meet & Greet on Main Street immediately following (Formal Dress with sash & crown) A horse drawn carriage will be provided unless other arrangements are desired.

Sunday, April 24 - Present medals at 5K Run (Casual dress with sash & crown)

NOTE: All Division Winners, title holders, & Alternates will be responsible for providing their own transportation & arrangements for parade entry if they choose to ride in the parade.

6. CONTESTANTS AGES 3-4 YEARS: An adult MUST accompany all contestants out onto the stage when they are called back out into line-up. Contestants WILL NOT be allowed back onto stage without an adult. This will ensure the contestants stay in order.

7. DOOR PRIZE RAFFLE- All spectators will be entered into a raffle for a gift basket sponsored by the University of Missouri Extension of Mississippi County 4-H.

8. MODELING MUSIC: Masters Entertainment will be providing music for all contestant modeling.
